TRANSFER: The mission of the Spiritans in UK keeps on expanding and reaching new frontiers. We are not only engaged in Parishes but in Schools, Airports, Prisons, Refugees and Asylum Seekers' programmes, Hospitals, Retreat Programmes etc, but to fit missionaries in such enterprises the hard decision is always made to make transfers—always with a view to putting round pegs in round holes. Consequently many of our missions, including St Chad's, have been affected. **Father Martin** has been selected for the dual role of School Chaplain and working in St Gabriel's Parish, Archway (Westminster Archdiocese). Consequently, we will begin from this week to raise funds primarily through second collections and the box at the back of the church for his farewell.

The month of **August** in the Catholic Church is traditionally dedicated to the **Immaculate Heart of Mary**. This devotion highlights Mary's pure and loving heart, which is seen as a model of perfect love and devotion to God.

<u>Key Feasts:</u> <u>Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major (Our Lady of the Snows)</u> - August 5—This feast commemorates the dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome, one of the oldest and most important churches dedicated to the Virgin Mary.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary - August 15—This solemnity celebrates Mary's assumption into heaven, body and soul, at the end of her earthly life. It is a holy day of obligation, meaning Catholics are required to attend Mass.

The Queenship of Mary - August 22—This feast honours Mary as the Queen of Heaven and Earth. It was established by Pope Pius XII in 1954 and is celebrated on the octave day of the Assumption.

<u>Devotions and Practices:</u> Novenas: Many Catholics pray novenas (nine-day prayers) leading up to these feasts, especially the Assumption.

Rosary: The Rosary is often prayed with a focus on the Glorious Mysteries, which include the Assumption and the Coronation of Mary.

<u>Special Masses and Liturgies</u>: Parishes may hold special Masses, processions, and other liturgical celebrations in honour of Mary. <u>The devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary is closely linked to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, emphasising the deep love and compassion both hearts have for humanity.</u>
